



ICTF Transtainer Training Course Outline

Transtainer Training:

(10 day pass or fail course, 8 hrs. per day)

DAY 1: (Training Room at Dispatch Center) (8:00 A.M. – 10:00 A.M.)

- 1. The Trainee will arrive at the scheduled start time, wearing all required PPE. Any infractions of either requirement, will result in the trainee foregoing their training eligibility.
- 2. The Trainee will take the Hand Eye Foot Coordination Test, then will be required to obtain a Pass/Fail Stanine Score of 5 or higher (75%), to advance in the RTG Training Program. If this requirement is not achieved the Trainee will forego their training eligibility.
- 3. Safety Contact
- 4. Welcome/Introduction
- 5. Review general safety and best practices within an ICTF Terminal
- 6. Review previous Transtainer incidents in detail, educate the Trainee on the root causes and key learnings from these incidents
- 7. Review a Transtainer Operator's role within the container supply chain
- 8. Review Transtainer manual
- 9. Review the various logistical phases and personnel of the ICTF cargo operation





DAY 1: (10:30 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.)

- 1. Induction to the ICTF Terminal, review the safety procedures and best practices of the terminal.
- 2. Induction to the ICTF Transtainer machine
- 3. Identify the Emergency Stops on the Transtainer
- 4. Identify the locations of the Fire Suppression devices.
- 5. Review the Pre inspection procedures
- 6. Review Transtainer controls, indicators and instruments.
- 7. Explain and identify the characteristics of a Transtainer.
- 8. Review the proper radio communication procedures and etiquette, for all corresponding personnel within the ICTF operation.
- Perform basic Transtainer Exercises with Rail Containers, using 40' &
 Containers & Trailers.





DAYS 2 - 5: (8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.)

- 1. The Trainee will arrive at the scheduled start times, wearing all required PPE. Any infractions of either requirement, will result in the trainee foregoing their training eligibility.
- 2. The Trainee will perform various exercises, using all sizes of Rail Containers & Trailers. The exercises will be performed under the direction of the ICTF Transtainer Trainer. Examples of the exercises performed during this time period of the Training include:
 - Review Twist lock light indicators
 - Load and discharge the various ICTF Containers/Trailers to the ground, railcars and chassis.
 - o Transtainer hand steering exercises
 - Proper exiting procedure of the machine, including turning off drives, pumps and returning machine to the designated parking area.

3. Day 5 Competency Pass/Fail Test:

The Trainee must successfully perform the following requirements to advance to Days 6 thru 10 of the ICTF Transtainer Training program. If these requirements are not achieved, the Trainee will forego their training eligibility:

- 1. The Trainee must safely and efficiently perform 15 movements in 1 hour or time equivalent, top picking containers.
- 2. The Trainee must safely and efficiently perform 8 movements in 1 hour or time equivalent, using legs to bottom pick trailers.





DAYS 6 - 10: (8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.)

- 1. The Trainee will arrive at the scheduled start times, wearing all required PPE. Any infractions of either requirement, will result in the trainee foregoing their training eligibility.
- 2. The Trainee will perform various exercises independently, using all sizes of Rail Containers & Trailers. The exercises will be performed under the direction of the ICTF Transtainer Trainer. The exercises performed during this week will be a more in depth version of the previous week, which The Trainee will be required to demonstrate visible competency and progression.

3. Day 5 Competency Pass/Fail Test:

The Trainee must successfully perform the following requirements in order to pass the ICTF Transtainer Training program. If these requirements are not achieved, the Trainee will forego their training eligibility:

- 1. The Trainee must safely and efficiently perform 20 movements in 1 hour or time equivalent, top picking containers.
- 2. The Trainee must safely and efficiently perform 15 movements in 1 hour or time equivalent, using legs to bottom pick trailers.
