

Ways To Protect Your Hands

1. Wear appropriate protective gloves for the job or exposure. <u>Do not</u> wear loose fitting gloves when handling cargo.



3. Beware of "pinch points" when handling turn buckles, lashing rods, chains, and cables under tension. Use caution while adjusting vehicle seats, windows and doors.



5. Do not use broken/damaged equipment (lashing rods/chains/tension levers) and be sure to grip handles firmly. Be aware of damaged ends of unlocking poles.

2. Never push or pull suspended containers around chassis and bomb carts. Never place hands under suspended containers and be aware of sharp edges.



4. Remove rings and wrist jewelry prior to all cargo and container handling operations.



6. <u>Use care</u> when handling equipment. <u>Never throw</u> twist locks in cone bins or luggage in baggage carts.
